

BOARD MEMBER JOB DESCRIPTION

- 1. Determine Organization's Mission and Purpose: It is the Board's responsibility to create and review a Statement of Mission and Purpose that articulates the organization's goals, means, and primary constituents served.
- 2. Select the Chief Executive: Board Members must reach consensus on the Chief Executive's responsibilities and undertake a careful search to find the most qualified individual for the position.
- 3. Support and Evaluate the Chief Executive: Board Members should ensure that the Chief Executive has the moral and professional support necessary to advance the goals and Mission of the organization.
- 4. Ensure Effective Strategic Planning: Board Members must actively participate in an overall planning process and facilitate implementation and monitoring the plan to ensure it achieves organizational goals.
- 5. Monitor and Strengthen Programs and Services: Board Members are responsible for determining which programs are consistent with the organization's Mission and monitor their effectiveness.
- 6. Ensure Adequate Financial Resources: One of the Board Member's foremost responsibilities is to secure adequate resources for the organization to fulfill its Mission.
- 7. Protect Assets and Provide Proper Financial Oversight: Board Members must assist in developing the annual budget and ensuring that proper financial policies and controls are in place.
- 8. Develop and Cultivate a Competent Board: All Board Members have a responsibility to articulate prerequisites for candidates, orient new members, and periodically and comprehensively evaluate their own performance as it relates to the organization's Mission, objectives and operations.
- 9. Ensure Legal and Ethical Integrity: The Board is ultimately responsible for adherence to legal standards and ethical norms.
- 10. Enhance the Organization's Public Reputation: Board Members should clearly articulate the organization's Mission, accomplishments and goals to the public as well as garner philanthropic financial support from the community.
- 11. Promote and Advance Good Donor Stewardship: Board Members will adopt a donorcentric approach in all fundraising and communications functions conducted on behalf of the organization.
